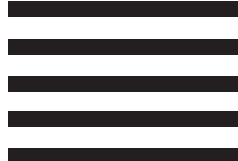

Who is MAGSA?

The McMullin Area Groundwater Sustainability Agency (MAGSA) was formed in response to the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA). The State law grants local control of groundwater management through GSAs. SGMA is an unfunded State law that requires subbasins be sustainable by 2040 through better management and balance of groundwater supplies.

How is SGMA being implemented?

MAGSA must submit a Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP) to the State by January 31, 2020. A GSP is the roadmap to groundwater sustainability by 2040. This will include a physical description of the groundwater management area, a water budget, management criteria, a monitoring program, and projects and management actions.

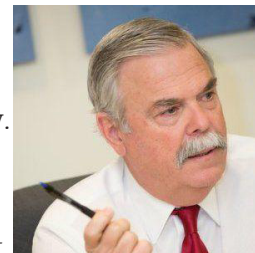
